

# Campership Application

## Clermont/Hamilton County 4-H Camp

**Due: Tuesday, June 1, 2021 by 4:00 p.m. to OSUE**

The Clermont County 4-H Committee is offering camperships, camp scholarships, to Clermont County 4-H members to attend Clermont County 4-H Camp. Camp will be held June 9-11, at 4-H Camp Graham, located in Clarksville, Ohio.

**Who:** To be eligible, applicants must be enrolled in the Clermont County 4-H Program. Campers must be at least 8 years old and in the third grade and no older than 14 years of age as of January 1, of the current year.

**What:** Camperships for 4-H members to attend the Clermont County 4-H Camp. Camperships may be funded for up to half of the cost of the camp base registration fee. Camperships will be allocated based on the funds available and the number of applicants and will only be awarded to the individual named on the application.

**When:** Campership applications are due to the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 1, 2021. Applicants will be notified by Wednesday, April 2, if they have been selected to receive campership.

**How:** To apply, submit a 300-400 word essay explaining why you want to attend 4-H camp and how you think it will benefit you. Please include your name, age, 4-H club, email address, and number of years you have received a campership at the top of your essay. Essay's should be typed or printed legibly and must be the work of the 4-H member. No payment is needed at the time of application, but will be required by the respective deadlines. Priority will be given to youth who have not previously been awarded a camp scholarship. Late applications will not be considered.
