## 2019 Clermont / Hamilton County 4-H Camp Counselor Estimated Expenses

### 4-H County Camp

Counselor Fee:	\$80.00
Background Check:	Approximately \$30.00 (if 18 at the start of camp)
Cabin Decorations:	Maximum \$20.00/cabin
Adventure Activities:	\$20-\$40 (optional)

### Other Expenses

There may be a small fee for some training events (i.e. overnight training, lunch at on-site training, out of county training events). Some training opportunities are optional and may require an additional cost.

All counselors should plan to provide decorations for their cabins, but not limited to, a welcome sign, bunk tags and door decorations.

**NOTE:** Due to University policy, there will be no reimbursements for supplies or any other camp expenses to youth counselors. All purchases must go through the directors.

Counselor fee includes a camp T-shirt, camp photo, training supplies and materials, food, Multi-County Camp Counselor Retreat registration fee, etc. Counselor fees will be due after selection, at the first counselor training.

The 4-H member's fee for 4-H County Camp is set at the rate of \$260. This covers food, general activities, camp fees and insurance. Your selection as a camp counselor qualifies you to have this fee waived. The cost is waived because you are being "paid" for attending training at a rate of \$6.50 per hour to cut back/eliminate the \$260 fee. **If you are more than 6 minutes late for training, you will not be "paid" your \$6.50 for that hour.** Counselors will be responsible for paying the amount of any missed training hours IN ADDITION to their standard \$80 counselor fee.
