Since most plants also have insects and some plants can be poisonous, no weed or plant sample are to be left at the office for the educator to identify without being in a sealed plastic bag (zip top or garbage bag).

You may e-mail pictures to the Extension Educator at neal.331@osu.edu, but identification is usually much more difficult. Samples may be brought to the office, but a picture is an acceptable first step toward diagnosing your pest or problem.
