## Treating, Removing, Planting, etc.

Contact a certified arborist through the International Society of Arboriculture

1. [www.isa-arbor.com](http://www.isa-arbor.com)
2. Click on “Professional Credentials” in the brown bar
3. Click on “Verify Credentials” to the far left
4. Click on “Find an Arborist”
5. Search by location by selecting your United States
6. Under postal code, type in your zip code and select radius to search
7. Click Search and your contact choices will appear

## Logging

1. Contact your District Service Forester to do a sight visit to help plan the trees to be removed and to build your forest management plan.
2. Get 3 quotes for loggers by visiting the Ohio Master Loggers website to find companies near you. Use this link to find loggers:

3. Make sure the loggers are using Forest Best Management Practices
